The Dudley-Charlton Regional School District, the Awarding Authority, invites sealed bids for the New Standby Generator at the Shepherd Hill Regional High School, 68 Dudley Oxford Road, Dudley, Massachusetts 01570.

The work involves all labor and materials necessary for supplying and installing a standby generator, which includes but is not limited to: demolition of existing, trenching and backfilling, fencing, concrete, mechanical, electrical, etc. Estimated construction cost is ninety-five thousand dollars (\$95,000). No pre-qualifications are required.

Bidder selection, procedures and contract awards shall be in conformity with M.G.L. Chapter 149 Section 44A-H. State mandated prevailing wage rates must be paid according to M.G.L. Chapter 149 sections 26-27H.

Drawings and Specifications may be examined and obtained at the office of Roy S. Brown Architects, 85 Chilson Road, Wilbraham, Massachusetts 01095 after Wednesday, October 25, 2017 after 2:00 pm. Paper copies of these documents may be obtained by contractors from the same office with a certified check or cash deposit of fifty (\$50) dollars per set, made payable to Roy Brown. This deposit is refundable upon return of said documents in good condition not later than ten (10) days after the opening of the bids. A non-refundable shipping and handling fee of twenty-five (\$25) dollars made payable to Roy Brown will be charged for each set of documents requested by mail. Documents requested by mail will be sent via United States Postal Service only.

A project walk-thru is planned for Wednesday, November 1, 2017 at 1:00 pm.

Sealed General Bids will be accepted from eligible bidders at the Office of the Director of Finance and Operations, 68 Dudley Oxford Road, Dudley, MA 01570 until 11:00 am, Wednesday, November 8, 2017 at which time they shall be publicly opened and read aloud. A bid security in the form of a bid bond, cash or certified check in the amount of five percent (5%) of the bid price must accompany the bid.

The Awarding Authority reserves the right to reject any or all bids, should it be deemed in the public interest to do so.
