The class of 2020 is unique and will forever mark our internal calendars as a class of difference, endurance and determination. As the school year winds down we are set to make some changes to our meals distribution program. For the last two weeks we have had a steep decline in the number of student families accessing meals. Starting next Monday, June 15, 2020 all meal distribution will only be located at Shepherd Hill Regional High School from 11:00 AM - 1:00 PM Monday and Friday. The last day for the Dudley-Charlton Regional School meals distribution program is Monday, June 29th 2020.

We have worked with the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education and all families accessing our meals program should have received a preloaded P-EBT card from the Department of Transitional Assistance on or after May 29, 2020 to assist with student meals going forward. Families who continue to be in need of student meals after June 29, 2020 can access summer distribution programs in surrounding communities.
