The Dudley-Charlton Regional School District shall ensure that all students have access to safe, clean drinking water at every school.

The Dudley-Charlton Regional School District shall conduct water quality tests of the wells at Charlton Middle School and Heritage School in accordance with or exceeding the requirements of the Department of Environmental Protection. The results of school water quality tests and, if necessary, any remedial actions taken, will be made available to the public in a timely manner via the district website (www.dcrsd.org).
