



Many ways to Volunteer at DES

- ▶ In the Classroom
- ▶ In the Library
 - ▶ (class time scheduled once a week, additional organization time requested)
- ▶ Copy Cats (copying for staff)
- ▶ Walking Club
 - ▶ (Monday, Wednesday, Friday)
- ▶ Cafeteria (once per month)

Ways to Volunteer at home

- ▶ Box Tops Program
- ▶ Home Helpers
 - ▶ (cutting, organizing, filing, etc.)
- ▶ PTO Events
 - ▶ Varies through the year

Safety First

- ▶ Sign-in/Sign-out is a must. We need to account for every individual in our building at all times in case of an emergency.
- ▶ While in the building badges are to be worn at all times. The students need to know you are a volunteer.

(The exception is Walking Club, due to the fact that it an outdoor activity.)

Safety Drills

- ▶ Due to the sensitive nature of security drills, all volunteers are asked to follow the staff member's directions.
 - ▶ Stay in Place, Lockdown, Fire
- ▶ Please do not take it upon yourself to change any procedures given to you by staff.
- ▶ Security is of the utmost importance at DES, thus all rooms are locked.

Communication:

- ▶ When you have questions about the policies and procedures, please ask the appropriate person -
 - ▶ Volunteer Coordinator
 - ▶ Staff Member
 - ▶ The Principal
 - ▶ We would love to hear any and all suggestions, as well!

Commitment #1:

- ▶ Your role is to support the teachers, students and principal in ensuring the success of the Volunteer Program.
- ▶ We understand that unexpected things happen....
 - ▶ Sick child/ren
 - ▶ Unexpected appointments
- ▶ If you are unable to attend on a specified day, please contact the teacher, or coordinator.

Commitment #2:

- ▶ Your attendance is crucial.
- ▶ All Volunteer Programs will be successful with committed volunteers.
- ▶ Without your dedication and willingness to help, these programs would not be able to continue.
- ▶ Thank you for your ongoing commitment to Dudley Elementary School.

Confidentiality:

- ▶ Remember to respect our staff and students' right to confidentiality.
- ▶ Any information pertaining to students and staff must remain within the confines of our school.
- ▶ It is your responsibility, as part of an educational community, to keep what you see and hear confidential.
- ▶ Your commitment and support of our expectations is essential to the success of the Volunteer Program in our school.

Dress Code:

- ▶ Although we do not have a formal dress code, the expectation is that all adults in the building will dress appropriately and with some sense of decorum.
- ▶ Please dress comfortably and maintain a professional attitude.

School "Etiquette"

- ▶ Act as positive role models for students
- ▶ Bucket Fillers (showing kindness)
- ▶ Bucket Dippers (being unkind)
- ▶ Bravo Bucket (acknowledge kindness)

Please follow basic school rules:

- ▶ Cell phones off or on silent
- ▶ Chatting with other adults is distracting during class time
- ▶ Not a time to conference with the teacher
- ▶ Halls are an extension of the classroom, please stopping by classrooms unexpectedly (it is distracting to the class)
- ▶ Siblings/Young Children (at the discretion of the teacher/ coordinator)

Interacting with the students

- ▶ Respect each student
- ▶ Speak softly
- ▶ Be positive and encouraging
- ▶ Reinforce positive behavior with methods that match classroom expectations
- ▶ Honor students differing abilities, don't compare work
- ▶ Encourage thinking and independence

Reminders...

- ▶ Please let the staff member handle any discipline concerns
- ▶ Please schedule your time with the person you are helping prior to volunteering
- ▶ Volunteers should not be left alone with a class frequently
- ▶ Please use adult restrooms only
