



Welcome to Second Grade!



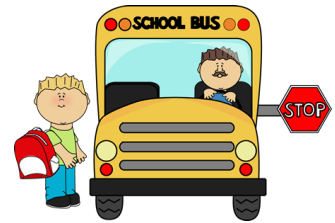

Dear Parents,

As the new school year rapidly approaches, we would like to give you some helpful hints and information to make your child's transition into second grade a positive experience.

Helpful hints to a successful first day of school for your child:

- Knows his/her home address (house number and street)
- Knows his/her phone number
- Knows his/her date of birth
- Knows the number of the bus he/she will be taking to and from school.
- Bus routes are posted by street name on the district web site (www.dcrsd.org)



Helpful hints for parents:

- If your child is going to be a daily pick-up and/or drop-off, please send a note in with him/her on the first day of school stating this. Any time there will be a pick-up change, please write a note.
- If your child rides a bus to or from a babysitter's house, a note must be sent in on the first day of school with the baby sitter's name, address and phone number. Be sure that your child knows the bus numbers!
- All lunches are served with milk.
- There will be a 10-minute snack time during the day. Please pack a healthy snack along with a water bottle or drink box – no soda, carbonated drinks, or glass containers please. Snack milk is not available.
- The Grade 2 supply list is on the back of this letter.
