

What does an EPP mean to you as a student?

That a Proficient Score (240) on the Grade 10 Math or English MCAS was not achieved

That the State of Massachusetts, had determined that you must keep moving toward a Proficient Score (240)

How do you show that you are moving toward a Proficient Score?

- 1) You must continue to take courses in Math or English and successfully complete them... earn credit in them.
- 2) You will have to test in Math or English again in your Junior year (in late April to early May)

IF you pass that test with a Proficient (240) ...
you are done with the MCAS requirements :)



IF you do NOT pass the Junior year test

In your Senior year you will have to...

- 1) Accumulate 4 credits in the subject – if you did not pass the class as a Junior, you will have to double up
- 2) Successfully complete all classes in the subject as a Senior
- 3) You will have to test in Math or English again in your Senior year (in late April to early May)
- 4) The Principal has to sign off on the successful completion of your EPP plan
