The below message is being resent as we have determined a possible receipt error with many gmail accounts. Email notification sent at or around 5:20 PM today, 03.09.2020

"I am writing to provide you with an update as the outbreak rapidly evolves. Again, we are taking this outbreak seriously and working with our town health agents to establish sound decisions.

In the late morning we learned of a Charlton parent who returned from an overseas trip this weekend. She did not feel well and went to Urgent Care. Urgent Care tested her for COVID-19. The results are not back and it is not a confirmed case of COVID-19. The family stated that the Urgent Care Doctor advised them that it was okay to send their students to school today at the Charlton Middle School and the Heritage School. Upon learning such, we contacted the Charlton Health Director Mr. James Philbrook and we had been instructed to have the students dismissed until we have a confirmation either way. The family complied.

As a result we authorized overtime for our custodial staff to deeply clean CMS and HS with the electrostatic disinfectant sprayer tonight. The Department of Public Health (DPH) does not recommend a school closure at this time. In addition, we continue to work with our transportation vendors to do the same.

We will continue to stay aware and work closely with our town health agents.
