I am writing to share that the Charlton Elementary School will continue with remote learning tomorrow, Monday, January 25, 2021. We have not received the results of testing from the end of last week and do not believe we will have substantiated data by the end of today. Additionally, we are evaluating the number of required and potential staff quarantines in order to provide a safe, orderly and productive in-person learning environment. We will continue to do everything we can to keep COVID out of our schools.

We apologize for the impact on our families and look forward to a return to the current model of learning within a short period of time at Charlton Elementary School. We appreciate your understanding and flexibility during the pandemic.

A joint meeting of the Health Director, Health Agent, Charlton Elementary School Principal and School Nurse along with Central Office Administrators is scheduled for tomorrow afternoon. Further decisions regarding next steps will be communicated out tomorrow after said meeting.

We appreciate everyone's effort to monitor and complete the daily [self-certification](#), district [pre-screening form](#) as this action alone improves our ability to keep everyone safe and healthy.

We have had a number of new cases and contact tracing has been completed. Across the district, the number of positive cases went down last week and we hope to continue that trend.
