All,

I write to share that we will reopen Charlton Elementary School tomorrow, Tuesday January 26, 2021 to in-person learning.

We reviewed the results of voluntary staff testing from last week's identified transmission in the school. It was determined that it is safe to reopen as we only had one new positive and contact tracing is complete. The remaining tests came back negative. Please note, this does not lessen the importance and seriousness of any positive cases in our educational community. We will continue to employ all of the mitigating strategies that prevent transmission.

We do expect and appreciate everyone's effort to self-monitor and complete the daily [self-certification](#), district [pre-screening form](#) as this action greatly improves our efforts to keep everyone safe and healthy. If a member of the Dudley-Charlton RSD educational community does not feel well, please do not enter our schools, but contact the school nurse. Let us continue to keep COVID out of our schools.

We have been informed of three new cases across the district today. Two required contact tracing which is complete.
