I am writing to let you know that we were informed late yesterday of two new positive COVID-19 cases in our educational community. Contact tracing was deemed unnecessary.

What continues to work and help everyone in our district remain safe, is when a family member, student or staff member believes they have been exposed from life activities outside of the Dudley-Charlton RSD or start to show symptomatic signs, please stay home and contact a medical professional and your school nurse. These actions continue to work and provide evidence that we do not have transmission as a result of attendance to school. This is a serious focus of ours and our school nurses are maintaining critical records of all cases and communications to determine if they are connected.

With the holiday coming next week, we know that a lot of life happens outside of our schools and is also the primary driver of positive COVID-19 cases in our communities. We know the safety of keeping our social bubble and work life orbits small will aide in mitigating new positive COVID-19 cases. Additionally, when outside of your bubble, if you do any or all of the strategies of wearing masks, washing hands, using hand sanitizer and maintaining safe distances, your actions will work to prevent transmission of COVID-19.
