We hope that everyone enjoyed the traditional snow day today. I am writing to share a few items of importance for you.

I am pleased to introduce our new District COVID Coordinator, Ms. Anne Marie DeMorris. We are very lucky to have Ms. DeMorris take on this unique role as a dedicated Dudley-Charlton RSD employee for many years and with her prior experience as the Head Athletic Trainer and Director of Sports Medicine and Wellness at Clark University. Attached you will see the updated DCRSD School Year Calendar as voted by the Dudley-Charlton School Committee Wednesday, January 27, 2021. The calendar does not reflect the snow day we had today, so for your records, please identify Friday, June 18, 2021 as the last day of school. The last day of school is an early release day for all students. In the event that we have additional snow days, our school year will enter the week of June 21st. If you have school-based Calendar questions, please contact your child's respective Principal.

As a district we are preparing for our transition to full in-person half days starting March 15, 2021. Attached you will find a letter regarding District transportation for this coming transition. It is critical that you review the letter and complete the [survey](#) by Friday February 19, 2021 to allow the District time to plan for this transition. We thank you for your feedback.

Lastly, the district has offered parents and caregivers the opportunity to enroll their children in the District hybrid learning model or select full-time remote learning. Throughout the school year, we have worked extremely hard to support movement between these models of learning. This movement creates incredible challenges in assigned classes and student schedules, stability in staffing and meeting student needs. As we prepare for adjustments to our learning models this March, we are asking parents and caregivers to consider their choice a commitment for the remainder of the school year. If you wish to change your child's learning model, we ask that you contact your child's Principal prior to Friday February 19, 2021 so the District can plan accordingly for all learners.
