C. Early Grades Literacy Grant (EGLG) Update

Dr. Perry will be joining DCRSD for the third year. The first two years were focused on learning new content and the Science of Reading. Year three is designed to be more pinpointed and specific to schools. Dr. Perry will spend time at the four elementary schools on a monthly basis to meet with principals and teachers, utilizing more of a coaching method in her teachings.

D. Grade 5 IXL

IXL during the pandemic was the right thing at the right time with remote learning, but now that the District is fully back, it's determined that the best option for all children is to work directly with the teachers in small groups. IXL doesn't particularly meet where the District is trying to go any longer.

The Principals still have a budget that they can use to buy IXL licenses if they feel certain students would benefit from that type of learning.
