Do you feel that you qualify academically to become a member of the CMS Chapter of the National Junior Honor Society? Would you like the honor of being in this group? We would love to have you! If so, you must have maintained a *cumulative* end of year average of 93% or better in the prior year and the first and second term of the 2020-2021 school year as well as a passing grade in Unified Arts. This initial criteria was established by the CMS Faculty Council in conjunction with the national organization standards.

In addition to high academic standing, potential members should also meet high standards of **character, leadership, service, and citizenship and be emotionally mature**. In order to complete the process for membership consideration, you must document achievements in the areas listed above by completing a student profile packet as well as answer a writing prompt relating to your qualifications.

Please read the packet directions *carefully* and complete all sections as requested. The Faculty Council at CMS will screen your application and award the honor of National Junior Honor Society membership to qualified students on behalf of the faculty.

All completed student profile packets ***must be returned to the main office no later than Friday, May 7, 2021. Late applications will not be accepted.*** If you have any questions or concerns relating to this process, please contact Ms. Sullivan or Mrs. Bassett.

In addition, we will be holding a virtual help session on May 5, 2021 for any questions relating to the application process.

- a. Give Citizenship Profile A to your current Team Leader.
- b. Once distributed, they are completed and handed to the NJHS advisors by the teachers. Profiles are kept confidential (nominees will not see completed forms).
- c. To ensure completion, it is *highly recommended* that applicants ask their teachers for verification of completed profile.

4. Citizenship Profile B

- a. Give Citizenship Profile B to Mrs. Logan (Unified Arts Team Leader).
