STUDENT DROP-OFF:

All students driven in to school must be dropped off at the front sidewalk in front of the building **no earlier than 7:20 AM** when supervision is provided.

EARLY DISMISSAL:

A note from the parent/guardian is required for early dismissal. Children are not to leave the school unless a parent or designee comes in to the school office and signs them out. Please have a photo ID ready when dismissing your child.

SCHOOL SECURITY SYSTEM:

A building security system is in place at the Charlton Middle School. This has enabled us to establish a visual and voice contact with all individuals wishing to enter the building. All individuals must state their name and purpose for the visit before entry will be granted. The doors are locked from 7:45AM until 3:30 PM in an effort to maintain a safe and secure school environment for students and staff.

TARDY/ABSENT NOTES: Attendance line is 508-248-1423, when prompted #2

All students arriving to school after 7:40 AM must sign in to the main office for attendance purposes. Please submit a medical note for dental/orthodontist/medical appointments. Physicians/Dentists will supply a confirmation of appointment note for this purpose. Please check with your healthcare professional. If you know your child will be absent/tardy, please leave a message on our attendance phone line with your name and the name of the student along with a reason for the absence/tardy. Please refer to the student handbook for a complete explanation of the attendance policy.

ATTENDANCE CONFIRMATION CALLS/TEXTS:

The Dudley-Charlton Regional School District participates in an automatic call/text system that is activated from our main office. After attendance/tardies have been recorded, the parent/guardian of any student who is absent without a prior call will receive an automated message and asked to call the school to confirm absence.
