#### **Shepherd Hill Booster Club Scholarship Information & Criteria**

Graduating Seniors interested in pursuing a Shepherd Hill Booster Club Scholarship are required to meet the scholarship qualifications outlined below:

1. The student and parent/guardian must be active members of the Shepherd Hill Jr. Booster Club/Booster Club for a minimum of 2 school years, including the student’s Senior Year.
2. The student and parent/guardian must complete and submit the applicable Shepherd Hill Booster Club Membership application, including parent/guardian dues, annually and by December 31st of their senior school year. Active/valid memberships will be verified by the Booster Club Scholarship Committee.
3. The student must be in good standing with the school and the community and will fulfill all graduation requirements prior to Commencement.
4. The student must have maintained a GPA of 2.0 or above.
5. The student must have participated in an extracurricular activity in the school or community.
6. The student and parent/guardian must each have volunteered at a total of 12 total events, with a minimum of 3 events in the student’s Senior year. An event = 2 hours. The student and parent/guardian do not need to volunteer for the same events.
7. The student’s parent/guardian must attend at least 2 Booster Club meetings per membership year. If unable to do so, the parent/guardian must volunteer at a minimum of 1 extra event per year.
