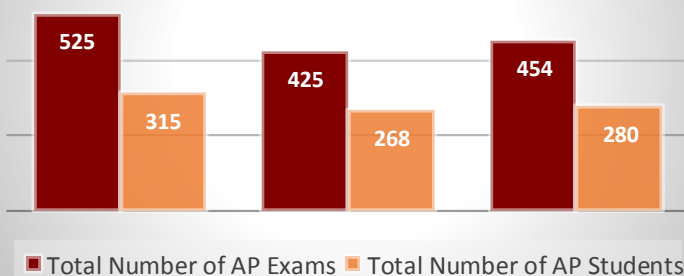


The SHRHS Class of 2017

The Virtual High School



Through Virtual High School, Shepherd Hill students are able to explore and enroll in an array of courses that would otherwise not be available. These courses provide students with the opportunity to learn in a virtual classroom and to gain important 21st century skills, such as multimedia presentation skills, online collaboration, and appropriate use of online resources.

Our Career Pathways program provides information for students and parents in identifying a post-secondary career plan and in selecting an appropriate course of study while in high school.
